To Our Church Family and Friends:

Have you ever had something that just did not make sense? You tried to get it, but it eluded you. I went back to Max Lucado to find a story of the Moravian missionaries who struggle to find a word in their native language for forgiveness. They finally came up with a cumbersome 24 letter word: issumagijoujungnainermik. This word literally translates like this "not being able to think about it anymore."

Max writes "To forgive is to move on, not to think about the offense anymore. You don't excuse him, endorse her, or embrace them. You just route

thoughts about them through heaven. You see your enemy as God's child and revenge as God's job. How can we grace-recipients do anything less? Dare we ask God for grace when we refuse to give it?"

This is a big issue in the Bible. Jesus was very direct and tough on those who refused to forgive other sinners. Matthew 18:32-33 NLT "You evil servant! I forgave you that tremendous debt....Shouldn't you have mercy...just as I had mercy on you" Max ended this message with these words "In the final sum, we give grace because we've been given grace."

Check these scriptures out Colossians 3:13, I Thessalonians 5:15, IICorinthians 13:11

May I encourage you to walk in the Lord, be an encourager, be a grace filled child of His who returns the goodness of our Lord with every step that you take. God will and does bless as you heed His Word.

"Please" sign up by Aug. 25th so we can order all the books we need at one time.




Samaritan's Purse Workday
