In a devotional I read last week a man from Clayton, Georgia wrote about our relationship with Christ. Let me share this with you. "Jesus was an either/or teacher. There was no middle ground when He taught His disciples moral and spiritual truths, and there must be no middle ground today. You say, that sounds mighty narrow. Yes it is, but Jesus taught in Matthew 7:13-15 that there are only two ways to live: the narrow way that leads to life, and the broad way that leads to destruction. Not much wiggle room: it's either/or. A little further in the chapter, He continues to be intolerant by contrasting life styles as being either good or bad. Ask most people you know about their behavior and they will say, I think I'm a good person. None of us want to think we are bad, because bad people should be punished. What makes a good life style? It begins with the choice to follow Jesus, and give Him control of our lives. Finally Jesus addresses the wise and the foolish. It makes infinite sense to choose the wise course and build our lives on substance, on the Rock. The wise choice is to follow Jesus. When He declared, I am the way, the truth and the life, no one comes to the Father except through Me, He marked Himself and all His followers as either/or people. This makes people either children of light or children of darkness, destined for either life or for death.

May we choose to hear and respond to the call that Jesus
