If there is one thing that God is showing me repeatedly lately, it is how the "young people" of the church can make an impact. When I say this, I mean the children. You know the ones that still can't find their backpack, that second sock, or remember to brush their teeth. But what I am also seeing is that we as adults do not always believe it or seldom encourage it. I want us to consider a few "young people" in the Bible.

David was only a boy when he killed a giant

1 Samuel 17:42 And when the Philistine looked and saw David, he disdained him, for he was but a youth, ruddy and handsome in appearance.

Jehoash was 7 years old when he became King of Judah

2 Kings 11:21 Jehoash was seven years old when he began to reign.

Josiah was 8 years old when he became King in Jerusalem

2 Chronicles 34:1-2 Josiah was eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty-one years in Jerusalem. And he did what was right in the eyes of the LORD, and walked in the ways of David his father; and he did not turn aside to the right hand or to the left.

The same God that led these young boys is the same God that we serve today. This past week in our Wednesday night study this hit me harder than ever. As I was teaching on the life of Jesus as outlined in the Gospels to some of the young guys, two of whom were just baptized we talked about the next steps as believers. I asked them rhetorically if someone was sitting on the train tracks and you knew a train was coming, but they couldn't hear it and were certain to be hit would you tell them? They all agreed in one accord they would pull them off the tracks. I then asked of the group, then how much do we have to hate people to know they are dying without Christ and not share the saving grace of Jesus with them. They have the power of the God Almighty living inside them, just like every believer young or old. First, I ask that we as adults, parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends set the example of sharing our faith. Then encourage them to do the same. If one children's lesson where I mention Peter Pan can influence a student's choice, and it did (Team Peter Pan has another!) then can you imagine what role modeling the Great Commission will do. Let's dust off our shoes and get moving for the Kingdom of God!
