To My Church Family and Friends,

We have heard a lot recently from the pulpit and possibly in our Sunday School classes about Spiritual Gifts. Some of you have taken the Spiritual Gifts Survey that Pastor Tony provided.

The phrase "spiritual gifts" does not appear as such in the New Testament. It has gained common usage, though, in referring to what Scripture identifies as the God granted empowerment for ministry on the part of believers. It seems appropriate to use the phrase "spiritual gifts" since they do come from the Holy Spirit and are given by God according to His own sovereign purposes.

The Bible lists nearly 20 different spiritual gifts. Though the gifts are many, the Spirit who grants them is one. God gives spiritual gifts to His people so that they might be effective and enabled for ministry. All Christians have tasks to perform in the service of the Lord in the church. Christians must avoid the temptation to be idle while they await the Lord's return. No one is ever meant merely to be a receiver of ministry; all of God's people both give and receive ministry. Churches will never achieve the level of ministry Christ means for them to have until all members are actively demonstrating their giftedness by engaging in the ministries which their gifts entail.

<u>Every</u> member is necessary for the church's growth and effectiveness. Love results when the whole body is properly working together—with every part contributing its share. Every believer is a unique part of God's plan for Austin Grove Baptist Church.

When churches discover the importance of an every member ministry, they will truly experience the growth of the body.

I encourage each of you to determine what your spiritual gifts are and, more importantly, to use them. When believers are equipped, ministry is enhanced, the church is edified, new Christians are established, the church is effective, and the congregation is enlarged.



We give out applications to students who need help with their school supplies. As you know, they are becoming more and more expensive. There are three churches who will be helping provide school supplies to elementary, middle and high school students in the Forest Hills district as well as a few students in other areas. This year applications were handed out on July 18th and will be due to our ministry on August 8th. Students will be able to pick up their backpacks, filled with supplies that were provided to us on a list from each school and each grade level within that school. Austin Grove, at my

discretion, has been assigned the following items to provide for filling backpacks: cow books (50) they are at Walmart for 50 cents each; yellow only pocket folders with prongs (30); dry erase markers, black or blue only (40); graph paper (25 packs).

In addition, there are 9 things that we, as a ministry group, will need to purchase. We will be purchasing 50 headphones, 25 earbuds, 20 packs of sticky notes, 50 mechanical pencils, 10 graphing notebooks, 30 1-1/2" binders, 50 wide rule composition notebooks and 25 yellow highlighters.

My family and I will be out of town and return July 27th. Please let me know if you want me to shop for you. Also, if your Sunday School class would like to be responsible for one of the four items we have been assigned, just let me know. Please sign up on the bulletin board so that only one class will sign up for a particular item. If you want to make a monetary donation for the 9 items that remain to be purchased, I'll be glad to shop for you after we are back in town. Actually, you can just text or call and I will shop while we are away and I'll have the receipts so we can settle up finances. Any help will be appreciated. Please pray for us as we collect and disperse backpacks to those children whose parents need extra help. Brenda Walker
