



To My Church Family and Friends,

Over the past year, during our Sunday morning worship and our Wednesday night services we have constantly heard two words: Evangelism and Discipleship. It has occurred to me that if asked to define these two words, some of us might struggle to. So, what do these words mean?

EVANGELISM is the act of sharing the Gospel, the good news about Jesus to bring people to faith.

DISCIPLESHIP is the ongoing process of teaching and mentoring believers to grow in their faith and become more like Christ after they've believed.

Think of **EVANGELISM** as the starting line, inviting people to start a relationship with Jesus, and **DISCIPLESHIP** as the marathon, guiding them to maturity through teaching, relationship, and living out their faith. They aren't separate but are two paths of the Great Commission (Matthew 28:1-20), working together to create reproducing followers of Jesus.

EVANGELISM

What it is: Proclaiming the core message of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.
Goal: To lead someone to believe in Jesus and accept salvation.
Focus: The initial call to faith, often a shorter-term interaction.

DISCIPLESHIP

What it is: Helping people learn to obey everything Jesus commanded—growing in Christ likeness.
Goal: Spiritual maturity and becoming a full reflection of Christ.
Focus: Long term relationship, teaching, mentoring, and life-on-life transformation.
Key Relationship
-Evangelism leads to discipleship.
-Discipleship includes evangelism as new disciples are taught to make other disciples.
-They are the front and back of the same coin, essential for the mission of making and growing followers of Jesus.

DISCIPLESHIP begins and ends with **EVANGELISM**. **EVANGELISM** first—you can evangelize someone but fail to build them into a disciple—but you can't make a disciple unless you evangelize them first.

I thank each of you for your faithfulness. Let's all commit, as a church, to grow the Kingdom through **EVANGELISM** and **DISCIPLESHIP**. Roger James

We deeply appreciate all the volunteers serving in Western North Carolina - from the teams rebuilding homes, to those coordinating these efforts, as well as the dedicated individuals who prepare meals and maintain our five rebuild centers.
